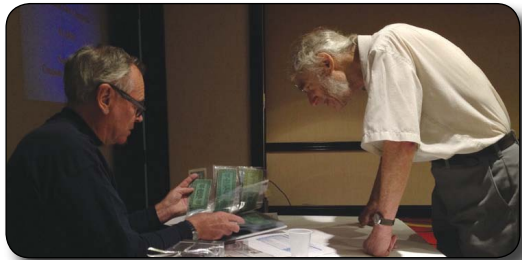

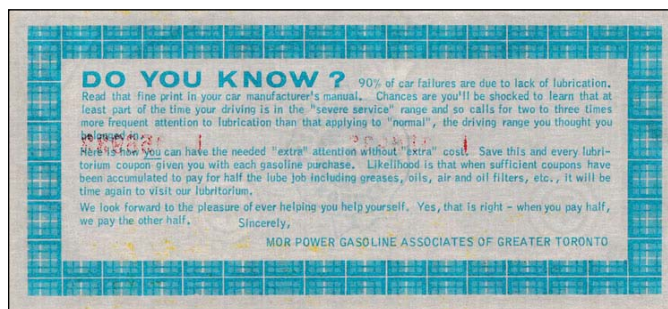
PREVIOUSLY UNKNOWN MP1C-10I LUBRITORIUM NOTE DISCOVERED

My father, Thomas Carlyle Stainton, was a hardware merchant in Toronto along with his father, before and after WW2. Together they owned stores at a number of locations in the Toronto area and in later years Beeton, Ontario.

Sometime between 1958, when CTC began issuing their coupons, and 1969 when my father sold his business, he began accepting the CTC coupons as legal tender. He saw this as a way to compete for customer dollars, eventually accepting coupons from numerous merchants including Handy Andy, Eatons, and Shell.



While I was somewhat aware of this practice, when he passed in 2003, I was surprised to see what he had amassed. It was at that point that I considered becoming a member of the CTCCC. It was not until very recently however, when I attended my first meeting on February 27, 2016 in Toronto, that I became aware that one of my coupons was unique. Having conferred with a few members, I decided to send a scan of my coupon to our Editor. Jerome replied to me that it was previously unknown and will be added to the Bilodeau Guide which is due out early this year.

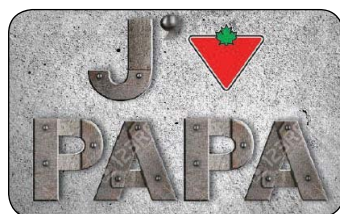

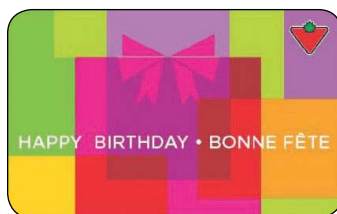

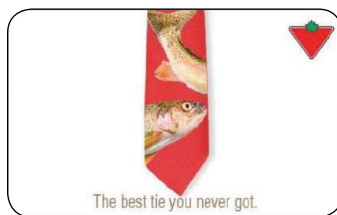

The eight cards shown above will be in the CTC stores at the end of April 2016.

The number to the right (#066-9711) is the Canadian Tire stock number. For brevity here I will use just the last four digits. Cards 9711 and 9714 will replace the DAD and the PAPA cards that were in use until now. The 9727 card is a new promotion for anyone and everyone's birthday which should have a very wide appeal to the general public. The 9728 card is a result of a survey asking mothers what they would like to

receive for Mothers Day - 65% responded "a gift card" and 64% said "flowers".

The new summer card 9729 is another attempt at a generic card that should have great appeal to the public. The new Fathers Day cards 9730 and 9731 are going to be issued for Fathers Day 2016. The 9732 "Tools" card is also designed to appeal to men, who, during the survey expressed their fondness for tools (95% gift card and 93% tools).

HOLEY CTC COUPON AND RECURRING INK PATCH ON SEQUENCE OF CT COUPONS

Ink patch manifestation on the coupons

I was contacted by a Canadian Tire (CTC) coupon collector after reading an article on Canadian Frontier Series \$20 notes (Doshi 2015) where the “Issue” text was truncated or cut off. These were called Truncated Issue (TI) bank notes. All bank notes that had this condition were with BPN/FPN of 61/61 but not all bank notes with BPN/FPN of 61/61 had this condition.

The collector pointed me to an article on printing imperfections on CTC coupons which occurred periodically in a pattern that repeated itself every third coupon in the order of serial numbers (Roebuck 2009). An unpublished article is under consideration for an upcoming CPMS Journal (Doshi, 2016) that explains some of the causes of periodic recurrence

of printing imperfections. I also had an opportunity to discuss this condition with some CTC coupon collectors. Further to this meeting I was contacted by one of the collectors who had come across a set of 5 cent coupons taken from a sequence of coupons which had a recurring ink patch (Image 1). At first glance it seemed like the ink patch was repeating itself every third coupon.

Were these patches of ink manifesting itself on every third coupon indicative of the same thing as other third note printing imperfection manifestations being reported?

The coupons presented to me had the sequence numbers shown in Table 1. The table also lists some observations that were unique to this situation.

Table 1 - Serial Number Observation - (Last four digits)

9308	This coupon had a patch of missing substrate (a hole) that was similar in shape, size and location to the patch of ink in other coupons.
9318	This coupon was not in a multiple of third from the coupon with the hole - 9308. The intensity of the ink patch on this coupon was lighter than the next two coupons in sequence.
9321	This coupon was a third away from the previous coupon with the ink patch - 9318. The intensity of the ink patch on this coupon was more than 9318.
9324	This coupon was a third away from the previous coupon with the ink patch – 9321. The intensity of the ink patch on this coupon was more than 9321 and was the highest of all coupons.
9335	This coupon was not in a multiple of third from the previous coupons with the ink patch – 9324. The intensity of the ink patch on this coupon was lower than 9324 and lowest of all four coupons with ink patch.

The first thing that is evident from the information in Image 1 and Table 1 is that the repetition of the ink patch is not consistently in a multiple of three. The second thing that is noticed is that the intensity of the ink patch varies – increasing with increasing number and then decreasing. Such a variation

of intensity over such a short sequence of notes is not consistent with the observations relating to the printing variations that have been observed for printing imperfections that repeat in a pattern of every third note (Doshi 2016).

Possible sources of ink that caused the patch

A starting point is to determine the source of ink that could have created the patch. The ink colour appears to match the colour used for intaglio printing on the face of the coupon. A closer examination of the ink pattern shows that it is also similar to the intaglio pattern corresponding to the same area on the face of the coupon (Image 2). Unlike other situations of printing variations with periodic repetition, the ink patch on the coupons is occurring on the side that is different than the

source of the ink, i.e. face ink is being applied to the back. This is the first clue that tells us that the ink patch is a result of an indirect application of the face ink on to the back. How does the back of the coupon come in contact with the ink that is meant for the face?

One way the ink gets transferred is through rub off or offset after the printing is done and the sheets are stacked on top of each other. When the back of the substrate comes in

contact with the face of the adjacent substrate which has wet ink, then some of it could get transferred from the face to the back. This is the most common method of transfer of intaglio ink from one side to the other and there are many notable examples of error bank notes and coupons that have been known in the collector community.

But offset and rub off are not the only way by which such transfer can happen. It is known that in the intaglio process the ink is applied to the plate cylinder which then transfers it to the substrate by pressing the substrate against an impression

cylinder (Image 3). If the intaglio cylinder were to transfer the ink directly to the impression cylinder then the subsequent sheets that pass through the press will have the ink from the impression cylinder transferred to the back of the substrate. A transfer from the plate cylinder to the impression cylinder is possible if the press was running without a sheet being fed into the press or if the sheet had a hole in it. In such a case the transfer of ink to subsequent sheets would also vary in intensity as the ink from the impression cylinder is used up.

Role of the coupon with the hole – offset or plate transfer

In absence of the coupon with the hole it could easily be argued and accepted that the ink patch seen in the reported coupons was likely caused by rub off or offset from intaglio ink at the time the sheets were stacked. This can possibly explain the lack of repetition every third coupon. The intensity could also vary based on the amount of rub off or offset. Had a continuous sequence of coupons been available this could be easily verified by comparing the coupon adjacent to “9324” as it would have a corresponding lesser amount of ink corresponding to the offset transfer. Although the possibility of offset transfer cannot be completely ruled out there are at least two considerations that give credence to an alternative explanation.

Firstly if the intaglio ink was applied with higher intensity to cause such an offset it is highly unlikely that it was not affecting every sheet in that vicinity. An examination of the face of the available coupons showed no signs that the intaglio ink in them may have been offset to adjacent coupons.

Secondly there is a coupon with a hole and that certainly would have resulted in transfer of ink in that area to the impression plate and from there to the back of the subsequent sheets. In such a case every third sheet would have been affected and intensity would decrease for each subsequent sheet printed.

Concluding remarks

In summary there are two possibilities to explain the patch of ink seen in the reported coupons. It could have happened due to an offset of ink upon stacking of sheets and some of the wet intaglio ink from the face getting transferred to the back of adjacent sheets. In such a case there would be no relevance of the coupon with the hole. Alternatively the ink patches are a result of ink from intaglio plate being transferred

to the impression plate which in turn transferred it to the back of the subsequent sheets. In such a case the coupon with the hole played an important role.

The only problem with the consideration of the coupon with the hole as a contributory factor is that, based on the reported coupons the first sheet that is affected is 10 sheets from the sheet with the hole and has the lower intensity. Also

there is an affected coupon from a sheet that is 27 sheets from the coupon with the hole in it.

The coupons that would be affected the most with a hole in the coupon with serial number of 9308 would be coupons with serial number 9011, 9014 and 9017 (assuming that serial numbers are printed in an increasing order). However these coupons are not part of the evidence. A possible explanation can be that there were more than one coupon with a similar

hole. For instance if the coupon that might have had a serial number of 9027 had a hole in it and if the serial numbers were printed in decreasing order from higher to lower than the pattern seen in coupons 9024, 9021 and 9018 could be explained. In absence of the complete evidence the cause of the ink patch on this sequence of coupons will be like the proverbial art whose beauty lies in the eyes of the beholder.

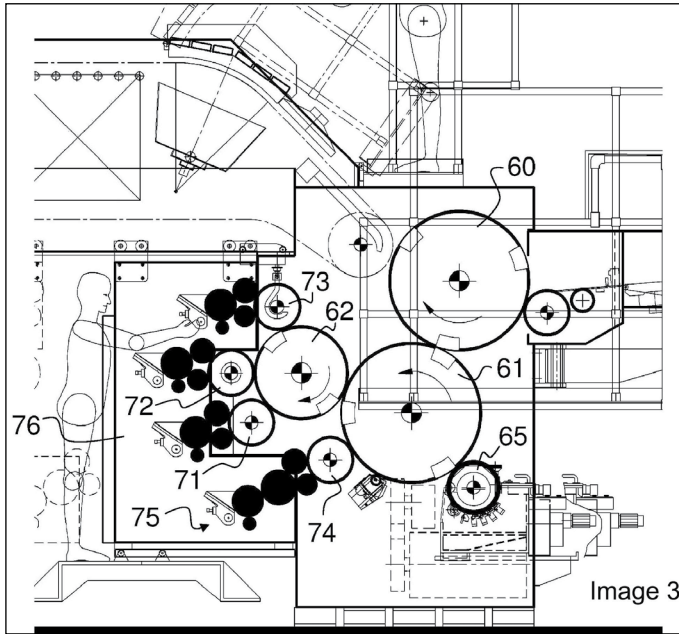

PRODUCT COUPONS - THE LAST OF THE ERA

Product coupons were first issued in 1988 with a total of six for that year, 2002 to 2012 saw over 200 coupons for each year. In 2013 only two coupons were issued and then they were stopped. They returned in January 2014 until December 31, 2015, but as of January 2016, they will no longer be issued.

All coupons until January 18th 1992 had blank backs, then only some coupons had a blank back, while others had printed backs. The front featured one product per coupon until August 2003, then they had as many as four products on the same

coupon. The first French coupon was the 1991, September 18th issue. Some weeks had up to four different coupons and either a blank or a printed back in both English and French. There are also some weeks where a different value appears on the coupon. On other weeks, coupons had different products listed for the same date. The only blank back coupon for 2015 was the December 31st which was the last coupon issued.

There were a total of 3,460 product coupons issued from 1988 to 2015.

While this one says 69% both coupons were issued June 6, 1992



Note that this is the same product as the June 6, 1992 but at a higher price and with a printed back. Many of the products were advertised multiple times and with different prices, dates and years.

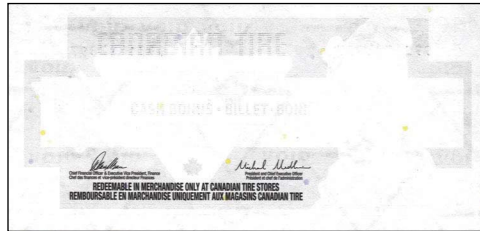
